

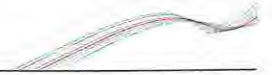

Proposal type	Details
<b>Minor and machinery in nature</b>	<p>This proposal is machinery in nature and will amend Schedule 1 of the Aboriginal Land Regulation 2011 (the Regulation).</p> <p>The <i>Aboriginal Land Act 1991</i> enables the grant of park land in the Cape York Peninsula Region as national park (Cape York Peninsula Aboriginal land) (CYPAL). In the first instance, the park land must be recognised as a prescribed protected area and therefore transferable land. A resources reserve under the <i>Nature Conservation Act 1992</i> is recognised as a prescribed protected area if it is prescribed by regulation.</p> <p>Implementing the Amendment Regulation will result in two actions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Omitting the Olkola (Kurrumbila) Resources Reserve 1 from the Regulation. This is appropriate as in June 2018 this land was converted to Olkola National Park (CYPAL). A prescribed protected area under the Regulation is a transitional tenure as land is expected to be changed to a national park (CYPAL).</li> <li>• Inserting part of the Endeavour River Resources Reserve described as part of Lot 2 on CP867124 and Lot 3 on CP867124 so the land is recognised as a prescribed protected area.</li> </ul> <p>When executed, an Indigenous Land Use Agreement between the State and the Bubu Nubuun Aboriginal Corporation on behalf of the Waymbuurra, Gamaay people and Nguymbaarr-Nguymbaarr people will provide consent to the dedication of the land as national park (CYPAL).</p> <p>The Department of Environment, Science and Innovation sought submission from the public about potential human rights impacts of the proposal. This notice was placed on 22 December 2023 and closed on 6 February 2024. No submissions were received which addressed the</p>



	<p>Civil and Political Rights outlined in Part 2, Division 2 of the <i>Human Rights Act 2019</i>.</p> <p>Accordingly, the proposal is minor and machinery in nature as it corrects the register of prescribed protected areas under the <i>Aboriginal Land Act 1991</i>. It recognises part of the Endeavour River Resources Reserve as a prescribed protected area under the <i>Aboriginal Land Act 1991</i> and does not result in a substantive change to regulatory policy or new impacts on business, government, or the community.</p>
